Our College is established by the sacred blessings of Jagatguru Swami Shree Swaroopananda Saraswati ji Maharaj. He is not only the Peethadhishwar of two Peethas but also a truly compassionate and universal personality. We, at SSIPMT, strictly adhere to the path of discipline and culture shown by Maharaj Ji and thus promote education of the highest order.

Maharaj Ji is currently the Peethadhishwar of Dwarka Sharda Peeth and Jyotish Peeth. He was born to Pothiram Upadhyay in 1924, in the village Dighori [Seoni District] of Madhya Pradesh. At the age of nine, he left home to visit the holy places of India, including Varanasi where he eventually studied with Swami Karpatri, a disciple of Guru Dev Swami Brahmananda Saraswati. At the age of 19, Maharajji became a freedom fighter in the 'Quit India movement' of 1942 and was known as Revolutionary Sadhu (serving two prison sentences for 9 months and 6 months). In 1950 Guru Dev made him a Dandi Sanyasi.

After Guru Dev's passing away in 1953, Swaroopanandji was guided by a new guru, Swami Krishnabhodashram ji Maharaj. Krishnabhodashramji was initiated as Guru Dev's successor by Swami Karpatri.

Swami Swaroopanandji became the President of the Ramrajya Parishad Party (set up by Swami Karpatri), and on Krishnabhodashram's demise, the post of Shankaracharya of Jyotir Math passed to Swami Swaroopanandji. In 1982, Swami Swaroopanand inherited the title of Shankaracharya of Dwarka.

We, at SSIPMT, have deep faith in Maharajji and as a tradition take His blessings before venturing into any endeavour.

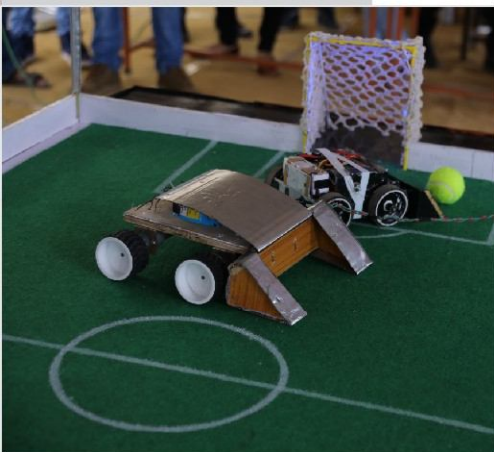

Innovations during COVID19



SSIPMT Raipur comes up with an automated sanitizing tunnel using limited resources during lockdown as its contribution towards the fight against COVID19. The tunnel can sanitize five persons in a minutes as soon as a person enters.

Department of Mechanical Engineering comes up with another small contribution towards society that is "Direct Splash Face Shield" costing just Rs. 20. The shield has been designed using a 3D Printer, also developed indigenously at SSIPMT Raipur.



"Touch Less (Automatic) hand sanitizer dispenser/ handwash dispenser machine" designed by the Department of Electronics and Telecommunications Engineering which releases sanitizer as soon as you place your hands under it.

"Semi Automatic Ventilator" designed by Professor Sumit Roy from Department of Electronics and Telecommunications Engineering. This working project is crafted as a mobile machine that will be useful for Ambulance as well as remote location availability.



Ankit Kumar Pithalia, B.Tech (CSE) who developed an "E-Chattri". The person holding E-Chattri will be surrounded by a circle having a radius of approx 2m keeping him at a considerable distance apart from others. The initiative taken up by members of Colonbreakers will help prevent the spread of Covid19 by raising awareness about social distancing.

Blind Boot an Application of IoT for Physically Challenged People (Student: M. Abhishek Rao, Shiuli Sinha)

This project is basically a shoe for visually impaired people which enable them to commute independently. It sends alert signals to the person wearing shoes if any object or hurdle comes on the way and hence reduces the chance of any such accident. It is featured by real time tracking of the shoes using mobile application.

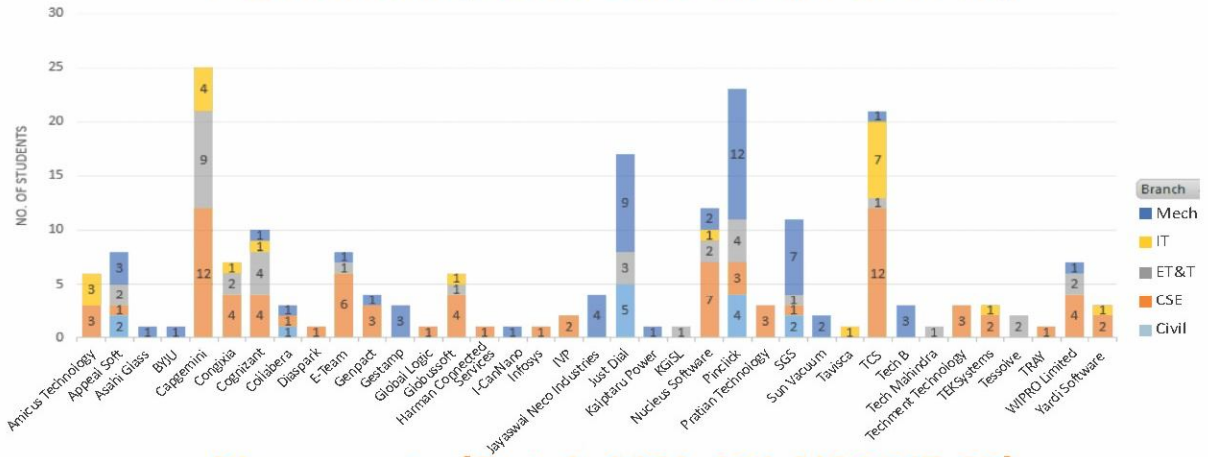
